SCRABBLE COMPETITION



KIDS AND K9

Dog Safety sessions are being taken with all classes this week.



Statistics show that a very high percentage of reported dog bites around the world are towards children, and most of

which are by dogs that the child is familiar with i.e. their own pet, or a friend or relative's dog. Dogs show very subtle signs when they are uncomfortable in a situation and all too often people don't notice these subtle signs and inadvertently put dogs in a position where they are only left with one next option and that is a bite. Kids and K9 sessions provide basic education to children



about those all important subtle signs (dog communication with their body language) and what are appropriate interactions with children and dogs and what are not.

Roz and her dog Tyke offer fun and interactive talks with groups of children.


HI VIZ VESTS




