CONCERNED PARENTS

Our parents who supervise the kea crossing on Gladstone Road are very concerned about the speed of cars travelling along Gladstone Road, through the crossing to school. One parent has provided me with the following information:

To travel 166 metres (distance from kea crossing to school) at 30kms per hour = 19.92 seconds

To travel 166 metres (distance from kea crossing to school) at 46 kms per hour = 14.94 seconds

Stopping distance at 30kms per hour = 11 metres Stopping distance at 40kms per hour = 17 metres 4.98 seconds – not worth a child's life!


