CONSENT FORM FOR EOTC PRIVATE VEHICLE TRANSPORT

Education outside the classroom (EOTC) is curriculum-based teaching and learning that takes place outside the school. At times a private vehicle will transport students to EOTC activities. School policy requires all drivers to be licensed and vehicles to be registered and warranted.

Example of lower risk Type C EOTC activities: Offsite - day trips, which extend out of school hours. For example: farm visit, day hike in a local bush, city visit, train or bus trip and swimming.

Prior to the event the teacher in charge of the activity will give parents/caregivers specific information related to the event.
