East Taieri School (3733) Enrolment Scheme

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the western end of Ashton Street, the home zone follows:

- North-east along Ashton Street until Shaw Street
- North-west along Shaw Street until the access way between Shaw Street and McDonald Street (between 47 and 49 Shaw Street)
- North-east along the access way from Shaw Street to McDonald Street
- North-west along McDonald Street until the access way between McDonald Street and Argyle Street (between 41 and 39 McDonald Street)
- North-east along the access way from McDonald Street to Argyle Street
- North-west along Argyle Street until Bruce Street
- North-east along Bruce Street until Gordon Road
 - Including Maranatha Mews
- South-east along Gordon Road until Gladstone Road North
 - Including Hagart-Alexander Drive between Gordon Road and Brookside Place,
 - And including Brookside Place
- North-east along Gladstone Road North until Friends Hill Road
- East along Friends Hill Road until its intersection with Chain Hills Road
- South-east along Chain Hills Road and continuing on Chain Hills Road until 408 Chain Hills Road
 - Including Friends Hill Road to the east of Chain Hills Road
- From 408 Chain Hills Road travels south-west along Chain Hills Road until Morris Road
- West along Morris Road until Coalstage Road
- East along Coalstage Road until Saddle Hill Road
- West along Saddle Hill Road until Scroggs Hill Road
 - Including Finnie Road,
 - o And including Scurr Road
- South along Scroggs Hill Road until Allanton-Scroggs Hill Road
- North-west along Allanton-Scroggs Hill Road until Ralston Street
- South-west along Ralston Street until Grey Street
- North-west along Grey Street until East Taieri-Allanton Road (SH 1)
 - Including Ralston Street to the west of Grey Street
- South-west along East Taieri-Allanton Road (SH 1) until Centre Road
 - o Including Peel Street
- North-west along Centre Road until the Taieri River

- North-east along the southern bank of the Taieri River until Murray Road
- East along Murray Road until Riverside Road
- North-west along Riverside Road until Bush Road
- North-east along Bush Road until Riccarton Road West
- South-east along Riccarton Road West until Gladstone Road South
- North-east along Gladstone Road South until Gordon Road
- North-west along Gordon Road until Burns Street
- South-west along Burns Street Ashton Street
- North-west along Ashton Street until Shaw Street.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the School Board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following enrolment period(s) for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

<u>First Priority</u> This priority is not applicable at this school because the school

does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary

for Education.

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current

students.

<u>Third Priority</u> will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student

of the school.

<u>Fifth Priority</u> will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an

employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of

the board of the school.

Sixth Priority will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in any priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under <u>Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1)</u> of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of In Zone address, or proof to support their application if seeking enrolment under the Out of Zone priorities.
