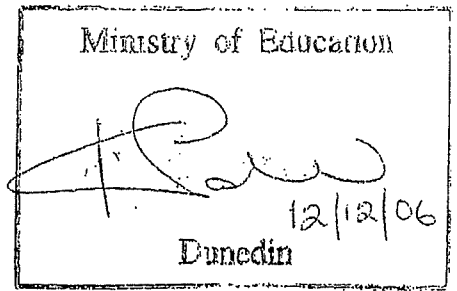


**EAST TAIERI SCHOOL**  
**ENROLMENT SCHEME**



## **Home Zone**

All students who live within the home zone described below (and/or shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

Includes both sides of the road, unless otherwise stated:

From the corner of Gordon Road/Hagart Alexander Drive, along Hagart Alexander Drive to Brookside Place. Along Brookside Place. From the end of Brookside Place across to Gladstone Road. Along Gladstone Road to the intersection of Gladstone Road North/Puddle Alley Road/Friends Hill Road, up Friends Hill Road and then a line across to Chain Hills Road. Follow Chain Hills Road to the intersection with Morris Road. Turn right into Morris Road and follow until the intersection with Coal Stage Road. Along Coal Stage Road and then turn right into Saddle Hill Road. Along Saddle Hill Road to Scroggs Hill Road, including Scurr Road and Finnie Road. Along Scroggs Hill Road to Allanton-Scroggs Hill Road. Along Allanton-Scroggs Hill Road to Ralston Street. Along Ralston Street to Grey Street. Along Grey Street and then turn right into Peel Street. Along Peel Street to SH1. Left along SH1 to Centre Road. Along Centre Road to Taieri River. Along the Taieri River to Riverside Road. Turn left along Riverside Road and follow to the intersection with Bush Road. Along Bush Road to the intersection with Riccarton Road West. Turn right into Riccarton Road West, a line to Ashton Street parallel with the railway line. Along Ashton Street to Shaw Street. Along Shaw Street to Bruce Street via the access way. Along Bruce Street. Turn right into Gordon Road from the end of Bruce Street. Then back to the corner of Gordon Road and Hagart Alexander Drive.

Proof of residence within the home zone may be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

## **Out of zone enrolments**

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary."

Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.


Third Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth priority will be given to applicants who are children of board employees.

Fifth priority will be given to all other applicants.

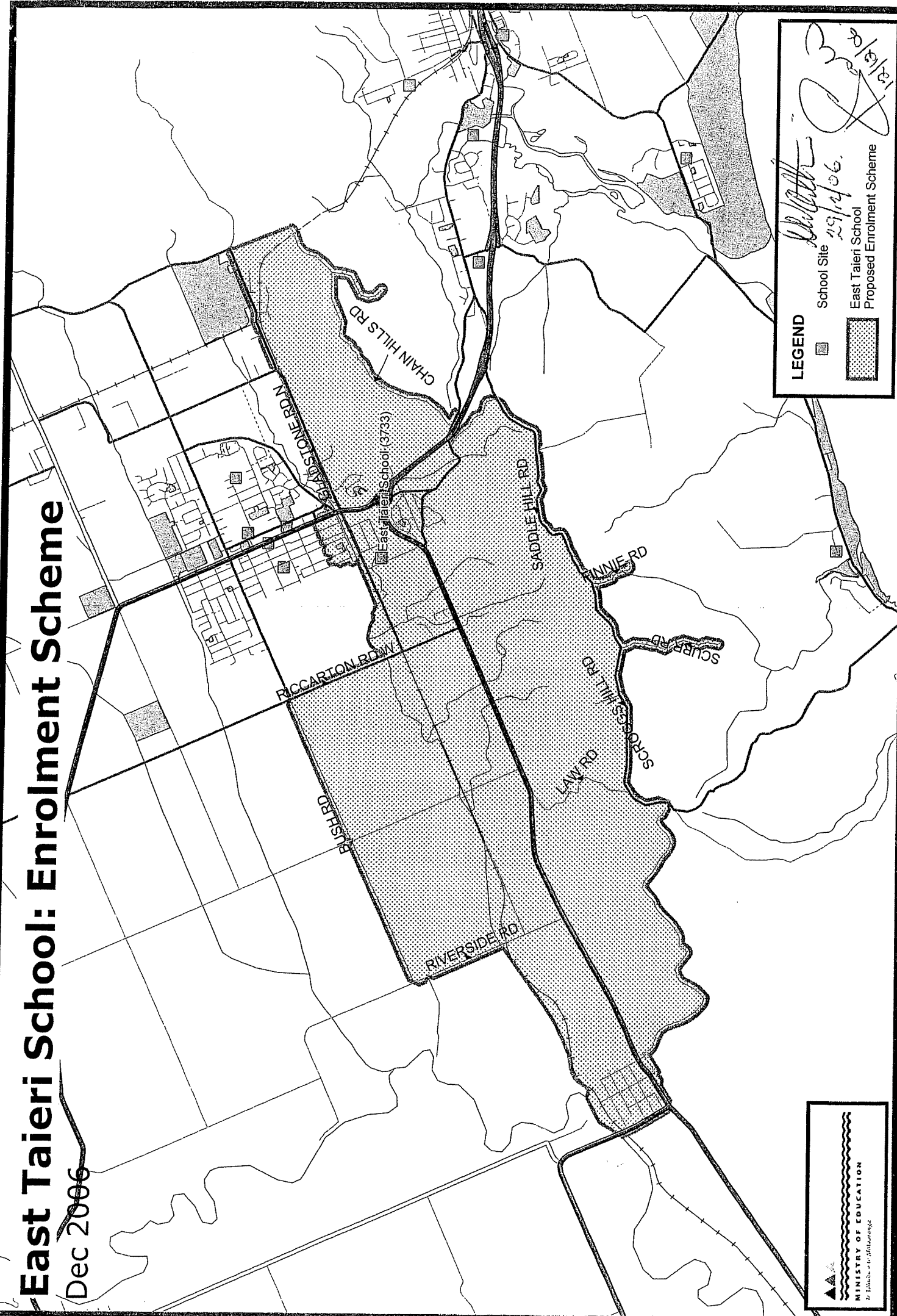
If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
